Antisocial Behaviour issues.

Community safety street surgery - Following the success of the last community engagement meeting, another one is planned for the New year. I am pleased to say that residents have reported an improvement so far. Any issues please do report.

Supporting residents with noise from the glass recycling - For many months I have been assisting residents with the noise issues from the station road Glass recycling centre in Alresford. This is the only site that is open 24hrs 7days a week and was moved next to a residential building. Support on this issue was also given by New Alresford Town Council when both residents and myself presented the information. Following receiving a formal letter of support from NATC and written requests from residents, I have now formally asked the lead strategic Director to confirm when this will be removed and asking if they can either pay Hampshire for the removal from the recycling centre or provide an increase in their glass recycling in Alresford. No other suitable places are currently available due to residents being too near.

Bishop's Sutton Footpath update - The anticipated start date has been pushed back due to the delay in receiving all the quotes. As these needed a budget up-lift (planned for within the project plan) the uplift came from the capital funding board. This needs Director approval before construction can take place and the next available date for this is the 18th December. At present dates are being sought where they can provisionally book road space to carry out the works.
