10. RESIDENTIAL PLANNING.

Planning Application

17/02298/HOU Mr Piper. Bishops Court Lodge.

Install a drop kerb for vehicular access to the rear of the property off the B3047.

Response from Highways Engineer Nick Culhane. No highway objections, however he suggested that the applicant provide an accurate drawing showing the ability to park and turn two cars beyond the wall.

PC A further additional exit onto the busy B3047 when the applicant already has access via a shared drive. Another major objection is the destruction of a part of a long flint wall which is a feature of the village. WCC Officers were refusing the application and objection from Martin Jay, however applicant submitted new drawings.

Pear Tree Cottage – recent large wooden building erected in the garden.

Members discussed once again. Mr Stubbs stated that he was holding discussions with WCC Planning Officers. Awaiting the result.

PN mentioned the condition of a sign on a path at Water Lane. PN said that this was No. 21 and he had some pictures which he would send to the Clerk. These had been forwarded to HCC Countryside Services.

15. DEFIBRILLATOR.

In order to raise further funds it is hoped that an interview with Alan Titchmarsh will take place next year.

16. WDALC.

There is a meeting planned in conjunction with a WCC Parish Meeting on 27th November 2017.

17. OTHER MEETINGS.

The Clerk had been invited to the Stagecoach launch of the new buses on the 64 route (Alton to Winchester) which was held at the Science Centre, Winchester on 13th November. The buses are made locally at Guildford and incorporate all the modern facilities e.g. lower height to access, WI-FI, Led lighting, leather seats etc.

18. GYPSY SITES.

It was reported that there were some people living on the Appledown Lane site who may not be gypsies but agricultural workers. WCC were treating the site as an existing gypsy site with planning permission.
