### **HWRC Booking System**

At my Decision Day on 27 January, I approved the retention of the booking system indefinitely at all Hampshire County Council managed HWRCs to support the management of customer demand and operations processes. The booking system, while introduced as a COVID measure, has proved adept at supporting operation and management activities at HWRCs through a predictable consistent throughput of customers and waste tonnages. The booking system has also proved popular with the public who appreciate that they can book a slot at a convenient time and attend the site safe in the knowledge they will not have to wait in a queue.

#### **Highways**

It was an unusual and mixed pattern of weather last month, with persistent rainfall not going unnoticed by many. While there were fewer salt runs than we might usually see in a typical December, Highways crews remained on standby, as ever, to deal with issues such as fallen branches and excess surface water, always to keep Hampshire moving. Statistics for last month reflect the absence of any carriageway treatments as none were planned for December, also the short Christmas shutdown when no non-emergency routine maintenance work took place. With further occurrences of heavy rain, followed by spells of freezing temperatures, likely we are now bracing ourselves for the inevitable increase in road defects being reported in February, prompted by freeze thaw cycles that can accelerate surface deterioration.

Reporting road defects online is always incredibly helpful to us and it remains the most effective and efficient way of ensuring reports are properly logged and prioritised for attention. The system we use also enables the status of reports to be tracked. Road defects can be reported online via:
