

City Councillors Report for September 2022

Day to day work of the council will continue, with a greatly increased work load for democratic services in particular, organising ceremonies at short notice under National Mourning criteria, of for which they have little experience.

All public meetings, for which an agenda and summons have been sent out already, will be held, but will be adjourned. Public meetings for which no agenda has been send out will be postponed.

Solar PV

We wanted to ensure that you are aware that the Solar Together campaign, run by HCC, has recently re-opened. This is a 'bulk buying' initiative whereby WCC residents can register an interest in solar panels, a battery or an EV charging point. A reverse auction is then held to produce most competitive price by installers vetted by HCC. The resident is then offered a price which they can choose to accept or not.

The application process is quite easy. However, there are questions about the size of your roof, its orientation and also about your annual consumption of electricity. (this is shown on your bills). Collecting this data beforehand makes the application quicker. People who already have panels already, can apply for just a battery.

Deadline for Registering interest is 27th September.

In the lack of any visible signs of support from elsewhere Winchester council are pulling together various pots of money to support those organisations that support others. There is also a small discretionary pot that will be targeted towards Council tax payers that receive additional help from the state but pay reduced or no council tax.

Winchester Council is also impacted of course, not only our own staff and operations, but for contracted services. Likely inflationary pressures have been reviewed and the £2 m. set aside to cover these risks is adequate for the rest of this and next year. However, the medium-term financial strategy is a great deal more challenging.
